SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR SUPERCARS

CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “PIRTEK PERTH SUPERNIGHT” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise races 11 and 12 of the 2019 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Barbagallo/Wanneroo Raceway, Perth, Western Australia on 2nd – 4th May 2019.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

- 1.5.1 **Track Length:** 2.42 kilometres
- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 32

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **1430hrs (AWST)** on Wednesday 1st May 2019.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives and Driver's Briefing** on Wednesday 1st May 2019.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1720hrs (AWST)** on Wednesday 1st May 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

2.2 PRESENTATION OF A CAR

2.2.1 Delete **Rule A4.3.3.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

A4.3.3.1 *I being the Authorised Representative of the Car described on the Supercars Entry Registration Form and legally authorised to enter the Car described on this form, hereby declare and undertake to Supercars Australia and the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) that the Car and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the Car to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the Car unsafe for the proposed activity.*

Further, I acknowledge and agree that where any aspect of the Car or related equipment and components is found:

- to be in breach of the Rules and/or the Regulations of the Event, or;*
- in the opinion of the ~~Sporting & Technical Director~~ Head of Motorsport, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect, it will render me in breach of the Rules, and that I may be subject to penalties in accordance with the Rules.*

2.3 HEARINGS

2.3.1 Delete **Rule B3.11.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

B3.11.1 After the Hearing has concluded, the Stewards notify the persons and parties concerned of their decision on the matter consistent with the information available at the Hearing, and subject to Rule ~~B8.2~~ B7.2 impose such Penalties and make such orders and give such directions as they may think fit.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.

3.1.2 Transporters must not enter the paddock prior to **1200hrs (AWST)** on Wednesday 1st May 2019 unless otherwise approved by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.

3.1.3 Other than Team caterers who have the required Transit Car Pass, Passenger vehicles are not permitted to enter the Supercars paddock from **0800hrs (AWST)** on Wednesday 1st May 2019.

3.1.4 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.

3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock.

3.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

3.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.

3.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Thursday 2nd May 2019.

3.2.3 Each entry will be allocated 3 x car passes for the Car Park B on the outside of the Circuit.

- 3.2.4 Each Team caterer will be allocated 1 x transit pass and will be permitted to enter the Supercars Paddock only for the purpose of delivering supplies. These cars must not park in the paddock, but in the Teams' Car Park.

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The accreditation centre is located at Gate 3 via Wattle Avenue East.

- 3.3.2 The Accreditation centre will be open at the following times **(AWST)**:

3.3.2.1	Wednesday 1 st May	0900 – 1700
3.3.2.2	Thursday 2 nd May	1100 – 1900
3.3.2.3	Friday 3 rd May	1030 – 2000
3.3.2.4	Saturday 4 th May	1000 – 2000

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk between **0930hrs** and **1130hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 2nd May 2019.

- 3.4.2 The Race Track will still be used by working vehicles and machinery during the Race Track Walk. As such, keep to one side of the Race Track where possible and be aware of your surroundings.

3.5 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS

- 3.5.1 Bump-In (Wed) – Circuit access will be via Gate 1 (Wattle Ave East).

- 3.5.2 Event Days (Thurs – Sat) - Supercars Series Accreditation as per Supplementary Regulation 3.2 will permit Team access to the Circuit and VCS Paddock through Gate 9 (via Mather Drive) from **0800hrs (AWST)**. Access prior to 0800hrs is via Gate 1.

3.6 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.6.1 All golf buggies must be road registered.

- 3.6.2 No buggy movements are permitted at any time between the rear of transporters and Team Garages.

3.7 STORAGE

- 3.7.1 Fuel drums are not permitted to be stored directly next to each other.

- 3.7.2 It is not permitted to store anything under the stairs that lead up to the corporate facilities above the Pit Lane.

- 3.7.3 Due to limited space in the Supercars paddock, no roll cabs or travel cases etc; are permitted to be stored in the Supercars Paddock.

3.8 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.8.1 Unless otherwise advised by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock on Saturday 4th May 2019.

- 3.8.2 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

4.1.1 The Medical Receiving Centre for on track activities is located in the infield Medical Centre situated behind the garages. The main Medical Centre is located on the outside of the Circuit near the south ramp and will be operational during the following times (**AWST**):

4.1.1.1 Wednesday 1st May 0900 – 1700

4.1.1.2 Thursday 2nd May 1130 – 1930

4.1.1.3 Friday 3rd May 1030 – 2100

4.1.1.4 Saturday 4th May 1030 – 2145

4.1.2 Any medical assistance that is required outside of the operating hours outlined in 4.1.1, please contact 000. The address to give to Emergency Services is:

“Your Specific Location” Eg: Garage 1, Barbagallo Raceway – entry via gate 1, Wattle Avenue, off Old Yanchep Road, Neerabup. Alternatively attend casualty at: Joondalup Hospital, Shenton Avenue, Joondalup.

4.2 PADDOCK WHS

4.2.1 Neither fuel or tyres are permitted to be carried across the pedestrian bridge.

4.2.2 The pedestrian bridge will be closed for all race starts and for the race 12 chequered flag.

4.2.3 The disposal of fuel drums and Tyres is the responsibility of the competitor. These items are not to be put in the bins at the Raceway and must be disposed of by the competitor outside the venue in a thoughtful manner and at the competitor’s cost.

4.2.4 Only oil can be placed in the waste oil drums at the Raceway. Oil filters, coolant, brake and power steering fluids must be disposed of at the competitor’s cost at a government approved collection centre. For further information see www.oilrecycling.gov.au.

4.7 HEALTH AND SAFETY

4.7.1 In line with the Western Australian Health and Safety Act, the Supercars Paddock including Teams Catering will be a smoke-free zone for the duration of the Event.

4.8 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 4.8.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 4.8.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.
- 4.8.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 4.8.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.
- 4.8.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 MARKINGS ON CARS

- 5.1.1 Delete **Rule E1.6.2.3** in its entirety and replace with the following:
E1.6.2.3 The surnames of each Driver must be
- a) Height: Sprint Events and DS2 Rounds: ~~400~~ 80mm
 Endurance Events: ~~50~~ 35mm
 - b) Font: Sprint Events and DS2 Rounds: Helvetica Bold
 Condensed Endurance Events: Helvetica Bold
 Condensed
 - c) Position: Lower edge of each rear door window.
- 5.1.2 Delete **reference 2, 4 and 8.** in **Schedule E1 Markings on Cars** in its entirety and replace with the below:

5.2 PENALTIES FOR KERB INFRINGEMENTS

5.2.1 With respect to turn 7 only, delete **Rule B7.6.1.1** and replace with the following:

B7.6.1.1 During any practice and qualifying session:

a) That lap time and the subsequent lap time will be disallowed.

5.3 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

5.3.1 Control tyre fitting will commence from **1430hrs (AWST)** on Wednesday 1st May 2019 in the Dunlop facility located in the Supercars paddock.

5.3.2 Tyre tents must be parallel with Team transporters, with the shortest side facing the garages.

5.4 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.4.1 The Event operating hours (**AWST**) for the purpose of **Rule E2** are as follows:

5.4.1.1 Thursday 2nd May 1200 – after VCS P1

5.4.1.2 Friday 3rd May 1145 – after VCS Race 11

5.4.1.3 Saturday 4th May 1125 – after VCS Race 12

5.5 BRIEFINGS

5.5.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1720hrs (AWST)** on Wednesday 1st May 2019 in the WASCC Media Centre – North located on the first floor above the race office.

5.5.2 A briefing for all Competitors and Drivers will be held at **1355hrs (AWST)** on Friday 3rd May 2019 in the WASCC Media Centre – North located on the first floor above the race office.

5.6 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.6.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Joondalup:

5.7 LIGHTS

5.7.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D3.2.3** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D3.2.3 The orange ID light must not be illuminated at ~~all times any time~~ that the Car is on the race track including the Pit Lane during race 11 and 12 unless, in the instance of the Cars headlight being nonoperational. In this instance the orange ID light must be illuminated. fitted with super soft Control Tyres.

5.8 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS QUALIFYING

5.8.1 In accordance with the specific prescriptions of **Rule D6.2**, in particular, **D6.2.2** the order of the Cars permitted to take part in qualifying for race 11 will be determined by the final classification of practice 2.

5.8.2 In accordance with the specific prescriptions of **Rule D6.2**, in particular, **D6.2.2** the order of the Cars permitted to take part in qualifying for race 12 will be determined by the final classification of practice 3.

5.9 SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

5.9.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D10.2.13** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D10.2.13 Prior to the lead Car crossing the Control Line at the end of a SC deployment, or on the restart lap, any Car that is two (2) or more laps behind the lead Car

must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is less than two (2) laps behind the lead Car.

D10.2.13.1 Should the SC be deployed eight (8) laps or less from the last lap of a race, or ten (10) minutes prior to the time certain finish time of a race as published in the Supplementary Regulations, any Car that is one (1) or more laps behind the leader must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is on the lead lap.

5.10 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PIT LANE

5.10.1 Delete **Rule D11.5.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D11.5.2.1 Only Officials, Team members in accordance with Rule ~~D8.1.8~~ D8.1.6 and media personnel specifically authorised by the RD, are permitted at the Pit signalling wall from the time that the Cars move off on the formation lap.

5.11 PIT STOPS

5.11.1 For race 11 and race 12, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

5.11.1.1 Each Car must complete one (1) CPS.

5.11.1.2 A Car may only complete its CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.

5.11.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.

5.11.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.

5.11.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.11.2 For this Event, delete **Rule D11.8.8** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D11.8.8 During any Pit Stop, from the time the Car leaves the ground until the time the Car has returned to the ground, the brake lock mechanism must be engaged so as the rear wheels do not rotate without the prior approval of the HoM.

D11.8.8.1 Where the HoM grants such approval, the rear wheels must stop rotating prior to the Car being lowered to the ground. For the sake of clarity, the rear wheels must not be rotating while the Car is being lowered to the ground.

D11.8.8.2 During any Pit Stop, a slight movement of the rear wheels will not, at the sole discretion of the HoM, constitute the rear wheels rotating.

5.11.3 For this Event, delete **Rule D11.9** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D11.9 Other than Sessions approved in D11.1.1, ~~Sunday Saturday~~ pit stop practice will not be permitted. ~~from the Phillip Island Event through to the end of the Season.~~

5.12 POINT SCORE

5.12.1 Delete **Rule D14.1.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D14.1.5 Each Driver will be awarded points based on the Final Classification of each race in the VCS and the DS2, subject to any Penalties imposed.

5.13 CONTROL TYRES

5.13.1 Delete **Rule D17.1.15** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D17.1.15 It is not permitted for a Team to seek, order or accept the direct supply of any H, S or SS Control Tyres from Dunlop.

5.14 FRONT BRAKE ROTORS

5.14.1 Only marked sets of front discs are permitted at this Event.

5.14.2 All marked front discs count towards **Rule D19.1**.

CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

6.1 SCRUTINEERING

6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0900hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 2nd May 2019.

CHAPTER 7 -MARKETING

7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

7.2 GRID WALK

7.2.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.

7.2.2 Promotional staff, Drivers and those listed on the **D23** personnel list are the only people permitted on the grid in addition to those that are wearing a grid sticker.
