#### CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

##### 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “TRUCK ASSIST WINTON SUPERSPRINT” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise races 13 and 14 of the 2019 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Winton Motor Raceway, Winton, Victoria on 24<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

##### 1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

## CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

### 2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **1000hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2019.
  - 2.1.2.1 All additional and Wildcard Drivers are required to present their licensing in accordance with **Rule A5.1** including a valid Car Club Membership to the Supercars Operations Truck by **1405hrs (AEST)** on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May.
  - 2.1.2.2 All additional and Wildcard Drivers are required to sign the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form by **1405hrs (AEST)** on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1405hrs (AEST)** on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

2.2.1 Delete Event 6 in **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events** in its entirety and replace with the following:

## 2.3 PRESENTATION OF A CAR

2.3.1 Delete **Rule A4.3.3.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

A4.3.3.1 *I being the Authorised Representative of the Car described on the Supercars Entry Registration Form and legally authorised to enter the Car described on this form, hereby declare and undertake to Supercars Australia and the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) that the Car and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the Car to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the Car unsafe for the proposed activity.  
Further, I acknowledge and agree that where any aspect of the Car or related equipment and components is found:*

- *to be in breach of the Rules and/or the Regulations of the Event, or;*
- *in the opinion of the Sporting & Technical Director Head of Motorsport, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect, it will render me in breach of the Rules, and that I may be subject to penalties in accordance with the Rules.*

## 2.4 HEARINGS

2.4.1 Delete **Rule B3.11.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

B3.11.1 After the Hearing has concluded, the Stewards notify the persons and parties concerned of their decision on the matter consistent with the information available at the Hearing, and subject to Rule ~~B8.2~~ B7.2 impose such Penalties and make such orders and give such directions as they may think fit.

## CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

### 3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.

- 3.1.2 Transporters must not enter the paddock prior to **0830hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2019 unless otherwise approved by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.3 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **1100hrs (AEST)** unless otherwise approved by the Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.4 All B-double transporters must be split outside the Circuit complex and be brought into the paddock as single trailers.
- 3.1.5 Other than Team caterers who have the required Transit Car Pass, Passenger vehicles are not permitted to enter the Supercars paddock from **0800hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2019.

### **3.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING**

- 3.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 3.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
- 3.2.3 Each entry will be allocated 4 x car passes for the Teams Car Park.
- 3.2.4 During the Event, after **0900hrs (AEST)**, access to the circuit is via the main gates on Glenrowan -Winton Road. The two right-hand side lanes will be Competitor only lanes for express access
- 3.2.5 Each Team caterer will be allocated 1 x transit pass and will be permitted to enter the Supercars Paddock only for the purpose of delivering supplies. These cars must not park in the paddock, but in the Teams' Car Park.

### **3.3 CREDENTIALS OFFICE OPENING HOURS**

- 3.3.1 The Credentials Office is located on the right-hand side when accessing the circuit (adjacent to the main gate), accessed from Glenrowan-Winton Road.
- 3.3.2 The Credentials Office will be open at the following times **(AEST)**:
  - 3.3.2.1 Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 0700 – 1800
  - 3.3.2.2 Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 0600 – 1700
  - 3.3.2.3 Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> May 0600 – 1700
  - 3.3.2.4 Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> May 0600 – 1300

### **3.4 RACE TRACK WALK**

- 3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk between **1630hrs** and **1800hrs (AEST)** on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
- 3.4.2 The Race Track will still be used by working vehicles and machinery during the Race Track Walk. As such, keep to one side of the Race Track where possible and be aware of your surroundings.

### **3.5 TEAM ACCESS TO CIRCUIT DURING EVENT**

- 3.5.1 Access to the venue via Fox Street will be available all day on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2019. On all other days (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) access will only be available between **0600hrs to 0900hrs (AEST)**. All access after **0900hrs (AEST)** on these days will be via the main gate on Glenrowan - Winton Road. The two right-hand side lanes will be Competitor only lanes for express access.
- 3.5.2 Supercars Series Accreditation as per Supplementary Regulation 3.2 will permit Team access to the Circuit and VCS Paddock from **0600hrs (AEST)**.

### 3.6 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.6.1 All golf buggies must be road registered.
- 3.6.2 No buggy movements are permitted at any time between the rear of transporters and Team Garages.

### 3.7 STORAGE

- 3.7.1 Teams are not permitted to store equipment in the empty garages if they have one beside them.
- 3.7.2 Fuel drums are not permitted to be stored directly next to each other.
- 3.7.3 Due to limited space in the Supercars paddock, no roll cabs or travel cases etc; are permitted to be stored in the Supercars Paddock.

### 3.8 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.8.1 Unless otherwise advised by Supercars, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to **1800hrs (AEST)** on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
- 3.8.2 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

## CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

### 4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

- 4.1.1 The Medical Centre is located on the ground floor of the race control building and will be operational during the following times **(AEST)**:

#### 4.6 HEALTH AND SAFETY

4.6.1 In line with the Victorian Health and Safety Act, the Supercars Paddock including Teams Catering will be a smoke-free zone for the duration of the Event.

#### 4.7 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

4.7.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.

4.7.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.

4.7.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.

4.7.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.

4.7.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

### CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

#### 5.1 MARKINGS ON CARS

5.1.1 Delete **Rule E1.6.2.3** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**E1.6.2.3** The surnames of each Driver must be

- a) Height: Sprint Events and DS2 Rounds: ~~400~~ 80mm  
Endurance Events: ~~50~~ 35mm
- b) Font: Sprint Events and DS2 Rounds: Helvetica Bold  
Condensed Endurance Events: Helvetica Bold  
Condensed
- c) Position: Lower edge of each rear door window.

- 5.1.2 Delete **reference 2, 4 and 8.** in **Schedule E1 Markings on Cars** in its entirety and replace with the below:

## 5.2 ADDITIONAL SIGNAL POINT

- 5.2.1 In addition to the flag signals shown at the Control Line, the following flag signals will be displayed at T9 the Black Flag and Black Flag with Orange Disc (Mechanical Black Flag).

## 5.3 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

- 5.3.1 Control tyre fitting will commence from **1200hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May in the Dunlop facility located in the Supercars paddock.

## 5.4 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

- 5.4.1 The Event operating hours **(AEST)** for the purpose of **Rule E2** are as follows:

5.4.1.1	Friday 24 <sup>th</sup> May	0840 – 1550
5.4.1.2	Saturday 25 <sup>th</sup> May	0740 – after VCS Race 13
5.4.1.3	Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> May	0745 – after VCS Race 14

## 5.5 BRIEFINGS

- 5.5.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1405hrs (AEST)** on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019 in the briefing room located in the support paddock.
- 5.5.2 A briefing for all **Competitors and Drivers** will be held at **1200hrs (AEST)** on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2019 in the in the briefing room located in the support paddock.

## 5.6 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

- 5.6.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Winton: <http://www.bom.gov.au/places/vic/winton/forecast/>

## 5.7 PRACTICE

- 5.7.1 Wildcard entries are permitted to Compete in the additional Driver practice Session.
- 5.7.2 **Rule D5.2.1.1** does not apply to Wildcard Drivers.

## 5.8 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS QUALIFYING

5.8.1 In accordance with the specific prescriptions of **Rule D6.2**, in particular, **D6.2.2** the order of the Cars permitted to take part in qualifying for race 13 will be determined by the final classification of practice 1.

5.8.2 In accordance with the specific prescriptions of **Rule D6.2**, in particular, **D6.2.2** the order of the Cars permitted to take part in qualifying for race 14 will be determined by the final classification of practice 2.

5.8.3 Delete Rule **D6.2.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D6.2.2.1** Qualifying - Part 1 (Q1): During the first ten (10) minutes of the Session only the bottom ~~fourteen (14)~~ fifteen (15) Cars in order of the final classification from the practice Session designated in the Supplementary Regulations will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q1, the slowest ten (10) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the ~~four (4)~~ five (5) remaining Cars will then be deleted.

5.8.4 Delete Rule **D6.2.2.2** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D6.2.2.2** Qualifying - Part 2 (Q2): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars in order of the final classification from the practice Session designated in the Supplementary Regulations and the top ~~four (4)~~ five (5) Cars from Q1 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q2, the slowest ~~four (4)~~ five (5) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the ten (10) remaining Cars will then be deleted.

## 5.9 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – 30 MINUTE START PROCEDURE

5.9.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D8.3.2.4** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D8.3.2.4** Team members may then approach the Car.

**D8.3.2.4.1** Team trolleys are required to be positioned directly behind the rear of the Car and perpendicular to the track direction.

## 5.10 SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

5.10.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D10.2.13** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D10.2.13** Prior to the lead Car crossing the Control Line at the end of a SC deployment, or on the restart lap, any Car that is two (2) or more laps behind the lead Car must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is less than two (2) laps behind the lead Car.

**D10.2.13.1** Should the SC be deployed eight (8) laps or less from the last lap of a race, or ten (10) minutes prior to the time certain finish time of a race as published in the Supplementary Regulations, any Car that is one (1) or more laps behind the leader must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is on the lead lap.

## 5.11 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PIT LANE

5.11.1 Delete **Rule D11.5.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D11.5.2.1** Only Officials, Team members in accordance with Rule ~~D8.1.8~~ D8.1.6 and media personnel specifically authorised by the RD, are permitted at the Pit signalling wall from the time that the Cars move off on the formation lap.



## 5.12 PIT STOPS

5.12.1 For race 12 and race 13, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

5.12.1.1 Each Car must complete ~~the one (1)~~ CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events.**

5.12.1.2 A Car may only ~~complete~~ perform a its CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.

5.12.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.

5.12.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.

5.12.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.12.2 For this Event, delete Rule **D11.8.8** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D11.8.8** During any Pit Stop, from the time the Car leaves the ground until the time the Car has returned to the ground, the brake lock mechanism must be engaged so as the rear wheels do not rotate without the prior approval of the HoM.

**D11.8.8.1** Where the HoM grants such approval, the rear wheels must stop rotating prior to the Car being lowered to the ground. For the sake of clarity, the rear wheels must not be rotating while the Car is being lowered to the ground.

**D11.8.8.2** During any Pit Stop, a slight movement of the rear wheels will not, at the sole discretion of the HoM, constitute the rear wheels rotating.

## 5.13 POINT SCORE

5.13.1 Delete **Rule D14.1.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D14.1.5** Each Driver will be awarded points based on the Final Classification of each race in the VCS and the DS2, subject to any Penalties imposed.

## 5.14 CONTROL TYRES

5.14.1 Delete **Event No 6.** in its entirety from **Table D17.7** and replace with the following:

5.14.2 For the avoidance of doubt and absolute clarity, the tyres as listed in **Table D17.7** **ADDITIONAL DRIVERS** are only permitted to be used in the additional Drivers Session.

5.14.3 Delete **Rule D17.1.15** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D17.1.15** It is not permitted for a Team to seek, order or accept the direct supply of any H, S or SS Control Tyres from Dunlop.

## 5.15 FRONT BRAKE ROTORS

- 5.15.1 Only marked sets of front discs are permitted at this Event.  
5.15.2 All marked front discs count towards **Rule D19.1**.

## CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

### 6.1 SCRUTINEERING

- 6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0900hrs (AEST)** on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

### 6.2 MINIMUM WEIGHT

- 6.2.1 In accordance with the requirements of **Rule C4.1.1**, all Wildcard Entry Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2019 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials at **0900hrs (AEST)** on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2019, in the scales garage.  
6.2.2 Full Driver apparel is required, including all underwear, gloves, HANS, boots, race suit, helmet.

## CHAPTER 7 -MARKETING

### 7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

- 7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

### 7.2 GRID WALK

- 7.2.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.  
7.2.2 Promotional staff, Drivers and those listed on the **D23** personnel list are the only people permitted on the grid in addition to those that are wearing a grid sticker.
