CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “TYREPOWER TASMANIA SUPERSPRINT” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise races 7 and 8 of the 2019 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Symmons Plains Raceway, Symmons Plains, Tasmania on 5th – 7th April 2019.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0900hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 3rd April 2019.
 - 2.1.2.1 All additional and Wildcard Drivers are required to present their licensing in accordance with **Rule A5.1** including a valid Car Club Membership to the Supercars Operations Truck by **1630hrs (AEDT)**.
 - 2.1.2.2 All additional and Wildcard Drivers are required to sign the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form by **1630hrs (AEDT)**.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives and Driver's Briefing** on Thursday 4th April 2019.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1630hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 4th April 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

2.2 FORMAT OF VCS EVENTS

2.2.1 Delete **Event 3** in **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events** in its entirety and replace with the following:

2.3 PRESENTATION OF A CAR

2.3.1 Delete **Rule A4.3.3.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

A4.3.3.1 *I being the Authorised Representative of the Car described on the Supercars Entry Registration Form and legally authorised to enter the Car described on this form, hereby declare and undertake to Supercars Australia and the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) that the Car and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the Car to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the Car unsafe for the proposed activity.*

Further, I acknowledge and agree that where any aspect of the Car or related equipment and components is found:

- *to be in breach of the Rules and/or the Regulations of the Event, or;*
- *in the opinion of the ~~Sporting & Technical Director~~ Head of Motorsport, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect, it will render me in breach of the Rules, and that I may be subject to penalties in accordance with the Rules.*

2.4 HEARINGS

2.4.1 Delete **Rule B3.11.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

B3.11.1 After the Hearing has concluded, the Stewards notify the persons and parties concerned of their decision on the matter consistent with the information available at the Hearing, and subject to Rule ~~B8.2~~ B7.2 impose such Penalties and make such orders and give such directions as they may think fit.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Other than Team caterers who have the required Transit Car Pass, Passenger vehicles are not permitted to enter the Supercars paddock from **0800hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 4th April 2019.
- 3.1.3 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.4 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock.

3.2 TRANSPORTER PARADE

- 3.2.1 The transporter parade will be held on Wednesday 3rd April 2019.
- 3.2.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements in relation to the Transporter Parade will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager under separate cover.

3.3 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 3.3.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 3.3.2 Accreditation will be required from Friday 5th April 2019.
- 3.3.3 Each entry will be allocated 3 x passes for the Teams' Car Park, and 1 x pass for the VIP Car Park.
- 3.3.4 Each Team caterer will be allocated 1 x transit pass and will be permitted to enter the Supercars Paddock only for the purpose of delivering supplies. These cars must not park in the paddock, but in the Teams' Car Park.

3.4 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.4.1 The Accreditation Centre is located at the main entrance gate to the circuit.
- 3.4.2 The Accreditation centre will be open at the following times, all times are **AEDT** unless otherwise stated:

3.4.2.1	Thursday 4 th April	0900 – 1700

3.4.2.4	Sunday 7 th April	0715 – 1530 (AEST)

3.5 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.5.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk between **1300hrs** and **1600hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 4th April 2019.
- 3.5.2 The Race Track will still be used by working vehicles and machinery during the Race Track Walk. As such, keep to one side of the Race Track where possible and be aware of your surroundings.

3.6 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS

- 3.6.1 Supercars Series Accreditation as per Supplementary Regulation 3.2 will permit Team access to the Circuit and VCS Paddock through Gate 1 from **0700hrs** Friday 5th April and Saturday 6th April **(AEDT)** and **0700hrs (AEST)** Sunday 7th April.

3.7 GOLF BUGGIES

- 3.7.1 All golf buggies must be road registered.
- 3.7.2 No buggy movements are permitted at any time between the rear of transporters and Team Garages.

3.8 STORAGE

- 3.8.1 Fuel drums are not permitted to be stored directly next to each other.
- 3.8.2 It is not permitted to store anything under the stairs that lead up to the corporate facilities above the Pit Lane.
- 3.8.3 Due to limited space in the Supercars paddock, no roll cabs or travel cases etc; are permitted to be stored in the Supercars Paddock.

3.9 DRIVER BATH WATER

- 3.9.1 Teams are not permitted to drain water from Driver baths onto the Paddock bitumen.

3.10 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.10.1 Unless otherwise advised by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to **1800hrs (AEST)** on Sunday 7th April 2019.
- 3.10.2 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

- 4.1.1 The Medical Centre is located at the Pit Entry end of the paddock and will be operational during the following times, all times are **AEDT** unless otherwise stated:

4.6 HEALTH AND SAFETY

4.6.1 In line with the Tasmanian Health and Safety Act, the Supercars Paddock will be a smoke-free zone for the duration of the Event.

4.7 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

4.7.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.

4.7.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.

4.7.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.

4.7.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.

4.7.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

5.1 MARKINGS ON CARS

5.1.1 Delete **Rule E1.6.2.3** in its entirety and replace with the following:

E1.6.2.3 The surnames of each Driver must be

- a) Height: Sprint Events and DS2 Rounds: ~~400~~ 80mm
Endurance Events: ~~50~~ 35mm
- b) Font: Sprint Events and DS2 Rounds: Helvetica Bold
Condensed Endurance Events: Helvetica Bold
Condensed
- c) Position: Lower edge of each rear door window.

- 5.1.2 Delete **reference 2, 4 and 8.** in **Schedule E1 Markings on Cars** in its entirety and replace with the below:

5.2 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

- 5.2.1 Control tyre fitting will commence from **0900hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 4th April 2019 in the Dunlop facility located in the Supercars paddock.

5.3 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

- 5.3.1 The Event operating hours for the purpose of **Rule E2** are as follows, all times are **AEDT** unless otherwise stated:

5.4 BRIEFINGS

- 5.4.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1630hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 4th April 2019 in the Media Conference Room, ground floor of the Event Management building.
- 5.4.2 A briefing for all **Competitors and Drivers** will be held at **1645hrs (AEDT)** on Friday 5th April 2019 in the Media Conference Room, ground floor of the Event Management building.

5.5 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

- 5.5.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Launceston:

5.6 PRACTICE

- 5.6.1 Wildcard entries are permitted to Compete in the additional Driver practice Session.
- 5.6.2 **Rule D5.2.1.1** does not apply to Wildcard Drivers.

5.7 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS QUALIFYING

- 5.7.1 In accordance with the specific prescriptions of **Rule D6.2**, in particular, **D6.2.2** the order of Cars permitted to take part in qualifying for race 7 will be determined by the final classification of practice 2.

- 5.7.2 In accordance with the specific prescriptions of **Rule D6.2**, in particular, **D6.2.2** the order of Cars permitted to take part in qualifying for race 8 will be determined by the final classification of practice 4.

5.8 SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

- 5.8.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D10.2.13** in its entirety and replace with the following:
- D10.2.13 Prior to the lead Car crossing the Control Line at the end of a SC deployment, or on the restart lap, any Car that is two (2) or more laps behind the lead Car must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is less than two (2) laps behind the lead Car.
- D10.2.13.1 Should the SC be deployed eight (8) laps or less from the last lap of a race, or ten (10) minutes prior to the time certain finish time of a race as published in the Supplementary Regulations, any Car that is one (1) or more laps behind the leader must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is on the lead lap.

5.9 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PIT LANE

- 5.9.1 Delete **Rule D11.5.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:
- D11.5.2.1 Only Officials, Team members in accordance with Rule ~~D8.1.8~~ D8.1.6 and media personnel specifically authorised by the RD, are permitted at the Pit signalling wall from the time that the Cars move off on the formation lap.

5.10 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – 30 MINUTE START PROCEDURE

- 5.10.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D8.3.2.4** in its entirety and replace with the following:
- D8.3.2.4 Team members may then approach the Car.
- D8.3.2.4.1 Team trolleys are required to be positioned at the rear of the Car.

5.11 PIT STOPS

- 5.11.1 For race 7 only, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
- 5.11.1.1 Each Car must complete one (1) CPS.
- 5.11.1.2 A Car may only complete its CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
- 5.11.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
- 5.11.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
- 5.11.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.
- 5.11.2 For this Event, delete **Rule D11.8.8** in its entirety and replace with the following:
- D11.8.8 During any Pit Stop, from the time the Car leaves the ground until the time the Car has returned to the ground, the brake lock mechanism must be engaged so as the rear wheels do not rotate without the prior approval of the HoM.

- D11.8.8.1 Where the HoM grants such approval, the rear wheels must stop rotating prior to the Car being lowered to the ground. For the sake of clarity, the rear wheels must not be rotating while the Car is being lowered to the ground.
- D11.8.8.2 During any Pit Stop, a slight movement of the rear wheels will not, at the sole discretion of the HoM, constitute the rear wheels rotating.

5.12 PARC FERME

- 5.12.1 In addition to **Rule D13 Parc Fermé**, Parc Fermé conditions will be imposed on all classified Cars from the completion of qualifying until the commencement of the corresponding race.
- 5.12.2 For this Event, delete **Rule D13.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D13.5 Permitted Activities – VCS

- 13.5.1 Unless otherwise authorised by the HoM, Teams are only permitted to undertake the following while any Car is in Pit Lane under Parc Fermé:
- 13.5.1.1 Check Control Tyre pressures;
 - 13.5.1.2 Loosen the wheels;
 - 13.5.1.3 Rotate the wheels;
 - 13.5.1.4 Install cool suit loop lines and remove dry ice;
 - 13.5.1.5 Position cooling fans in the radiator and/or brake duct intakes in the front bumper bar;
 - 13.5.1.6 Connect auxiliary power pack.
- 13.5.2 Unless otherwise authorised by the HoM, Teams are only permitted to undertake the following while any Car is in their garage under Parc Fermé:
- 13.5.2.1 Cars permitted to be placed on double high stands;
 - 13.5.2.2 Remove and refit wheels and adjust tyre pressures as required;
 - 13.5.2.3 Install/remove cool suit loop lines and service dry ice systems;
 - 13.5.2.4 Service Driver drink containers;
 - 13.5.2.5 Position cooling fans in the radiator and/or brake duct intakes in the front bumper bar;
 - 13.5.2.6 Connect heaters associated with engine/gearbox warming;
 - 13.5.2.7 Connect auxiliary power pack or battery charger;
 - 13.5.2.8 Drain and refill fuel system;
 - 13.5.2.9 Inspect and refill all oils and fluids as required;
 - 13.5.2.10 Download/upload data to/from the ECU and data logger;
 - 13.5.2.11 Add/remove radiator/transmission/brake cooling blanking covers;
 - 13.5.2.12 Cleaning of radiator and oil coolers;
 - 13.5.2.13 Cleaning of interior and exterior of the Car;
 - 13.5.2.14 Remove and replace the in car camera's SD card;
 - 13.5.2.15 Brake system servicing following permission of the HoM;
 - 13.5.2.16 Damage repairs permitted following permission of the HoM;
 - 13.5.2.17 Starting of Car engines and warming up of drivetrain.

5.13 POINT SCORE

5.13.1 Delete **Rule D14.1.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D14.1.5 Each Driver will be awarded points based on the Final Classification of each race in the VCS and the DS2, subject to any Penalties imposed.

5.14 CONTROL TYRES

5.14.1 Delete **Event No 3.** in its entirety from **Table D17.7** and replace with the following:

5.14.2 For the avoidance of doubt and absolute clarity, the tyres as listed in **Table D17.7** ADDITIONAL DRIVERS are only permitted to be used in the additional Drivers Session.

5.14.3 Delete **Rule D17.1.15** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D17.1.15 It is not permitted for a Team to seek, order or accept the direct supply of any H, S or SS Control Tyres from Dunlop.

5.15 FRONT BRAKE ROTORS

5.15.1 Only marked sets of front discs are permitted at this Event.

5.15.2 All marked front discs count towards **Rule D19.1**.

CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

6.1 SCRUTINEERING

6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0830hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 4th April 2019.

6.2 MINIMUM WEIGHT

6.2.1 In accordance with the requirements of **Rule C4.1.1**, all Wildcard Entry Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2019 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials at **1000hrs (AEDT)** on Friday 5th April 2019, in the scales garage.

6.2.1.1 Full Driver apparel is required, including all underwear, gloves, HANS, boots, race suit, helmet.

6.3 OTHER BRAKE SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

6.3.1 For this Event, delete **C11.4 Other Brake System Requirements** in its entirety and replace with the following:

C11.4 Other Brake System Requirements

C11.4.1 The fitment of a brake lock mechanism consisting of a hydraulic solenoid valve that when operational locks the rear wheels is mandatory. The operation of the brake lock mechanism must only be by an on/off switch.

C11.4.1.1 A cable or hydraulically operated handbrake system is permitted as a brake lock mechanism with the prior approval of the HoM. If in operation it must only be located and operated by a lever located on either side of the Driver's seat.

C11.4.1.2 In addition to Rule C11.4.1 the fitment of a brake lock mechanism consisting of a hydraulic solenoid valve that when operational locks the front wheels is optional. The operation of the brake lock mechanism must only be by an on/off switch.

C11.4.2 The brake lock mechanism is only permitted to be used to stop the Car rolling from a standing start. The Operation of the brake lock mechanism cannot be automated in any manner and must be operated by the Driver as detailed in Rule C11.4.1.

C11.4.2.1 The brake lock mechanism, must be manually engaged during a pit stop for the sole purpose of stopping the rear wheels from turning during that stop. The disengagement of the brake lock mechanism at the end of a pit stop must be automated. The automation logic and any subsequent revisions must be approved by the HoM.

C11.4.2.2 Use of the brake lock mechanism in any situation/environment other than Rule C11.4.2 and Rule C11.4.2.1 is not permitted.

C11.4.3 The braking system pressure in both front calipers must remain equal at all times.

C11.4.4 The control pedal box provides a system, which allows the brake balance of a Car to be adjusted manually by the Driver. The force required to make such an adjustment must be generated and controlled by the Driver, seated normally in the Car with the safety harness correctly fastened.
