**GUIDELINES**

*By registering for the Supercars Students on Track program,  
your school is agreeing to the below guidelines.*

## **PRE-EVENT**

### **TICKETS**

Students on Track (**SOT**) tickets will be sent to schools who have registered to attend the event as part of the program no later than one (1) month out from the event.

Schools will be provided with SOT tickets and lanyards for each attending teacher, accompanying parent and student.

If the tickets have not arrived at least one (1) month out from the event or if additional tickets are required, all requests must be made to [sot@supercars.com](mailto:sot@supercars.com).

### **RISK ASSESSMENT**

All schools who register for the SOT program will be provided with Supercars' Risk Assessment document. This will be emailed to all schools as part of their registration confirmation email.

### **WORKBOOKS**

Workbooks will be sent out to all schools via email approximately two (2) weeks before the event. There is a primary and secondary school workbook with both booklets outlining how Supercars relates to science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (**STEM**) and aligns with the Australian Curriculum.

The workbooks have been designed to be completed by students either independently or collaboratively and can be utilised either on the day or back in the classroom.

Workbooks will be supplied as digital PDF documents only. Schools are required to download and print the workbooks to use on ground at the event with their students.

Answer booklets will also be provided.

## AT THE EVENT

### TICKETS

SOT tickets can only be used on the Friday of the event during the gates opening and 3pm. SOT tickets will not permit entry outside of these times.

All students and teachers attending the event as part of the program must have a SOT ticket. SOT tickets must be displayed at all times via the lanyard supplied to schools when they register.

### SUPERVISION OF STUDENTS

Students must be supervised at all times and have a teacher or accompanying parent with them while at the event.

The teacher or accompanying parent are responsible for the care, conduct and supervision of those students and must keep those students within sight at all times.

Students are not permitted to leave the event precinct during the SOT program without an accompanying teacher or parent. Students will be stopped trying to re-enter the event without an accompanying teacher or parent.

If students attempt to re-enter the event without an accompanying teacher or parent, the students will be refused entry into the event and the school will be immediately contacted. As a consequence, the school may be prohibited from participating in future SOT programs.

### STUDENT UNIFORM

Students must be in their school uniform while attending the event as part of the SOT program. If the school does not have a uniform, the school needs to email [sot@supercars.com](mailto:sot@supercars.com) before the event to inform Supercars.

All students and teachers wear enclosed footwear while attending the event as part of the program.

The Event takes place outdoors, so conditions may vary (including access, seating, and protection from weather, terrain and available facilities). Some areas at the Event are exposed to direct sunlight and heat. Schools are to take appropriate care for their student's wellbeing at the Event including but not limited to hydration and sun protection.

### ACCESS TO AREAS AT THE EVENT

The SOT program allows students to access all trackside areas of the event. Students are not permitted in corporate areas or any grandstands.

Students are permitted entry to the Supercars paddock area (**Paddock**). Unaccompanied students will be asked to leave the Paddock by security immediately for their own safety as there are moving vehicles and equipment on ground. **Please Note** – the Gold Coast 600 and Newcastle 500 does **NOT** include access to the Paddock as there is no paddock at these events.

The Auckland Super400 does **NOT** feature team transporters in the Paddock.

Supercars reserves the right to close the Paddock or restrict access to the Paddock at any time.

There are a number of food outlets located around the event precinct. Students may bring in limited quantities of food and drink for personal consumption.
